## **BASS & TENOR DRUMMING**

### SYLLABUS

#### **Level 4 - Novice Certificate**

This would effectively represent all Bass and Tenor players from Novice (entry grade) through Amateur Solo Grade 3.

Candidates will be able to demonstrate their knowledge of:

- Recognition of time signatures and their meanings
- Counting beats in simple time
- Reading and playing simple rhythm beatings
- Be familiar with and demonstrate a knowledge of the EUSPBA flourish symbols
- The four primary flourishes
- Recognition of note values and rests
- The parts of the bass and tenor drum and a beginning knowledge of tuning.
- Performing – bass and rhythm tenor will play a march set, of their choice, of either a four-parted 4/4's or two, two-parted, 2/4's. Traditional tenors will perform a four-part 4/4 demonstrating an understanding of Piano/Forte and flourish development.
